<p>1. The meeting began with a short presentation by Rence Callahan reviewing the Concept Development and Schematic Design schedule. The next meeting to review schematic design will be Monday 2/13/06.</p> <p>Conversations between the historic preservation consultants History Matters and the Federal listing administrator indicate that the designation can be maintained with each of the concepts presented. The designation can be maintained if the preservation communities of Greensboro agree that the selected scheme responds appropriately to the preservation needs of the stadium.</p>		Establish meetings on calendar.
<p>2. Steve Barnes began with a presentation of three stadium concepts, each illustrating the eight significant planning factors shown in previous schemes. Copies of the schemes are attached. The purpose of this meeting was to receive comments and direction in refining the three plans for schematic design.</p> <p><i>Comments from the committee included;</i></p>	WRCP	Refine three schemes for February 13.
<p>3. Does the State Historic Preservation Office know of the conversations with our consultants? History Matters was scheduled to call Ann Swallow with an update and report the conversations with Dan Vivian in Washington.</p> <p>Will the press box be renovated? We will investigate the historic disposition of the press box and renovate or replace as required by the program.</p> <p>In scheme 3 the superstructure should be acknowledged as part of any plaza construction. Complete demolition without reference to the existing doesn't seem to be adequate.</p> <p>There are 3 sections of existing seating along the third base line. One is buried below the "Grandstand". Any plaza should acknowledge this seat arrangement.</p>
